Influenza Vaccine

➤ **90662 (Fluzone High Dose)**

- Adults age 65 years & older

➤ **90685 (Fluzone)**

- Children ages 6 months to 35 months

➤ **90686 (Fluzone)**

- Children ages 3 years to 18 years
- Adults ages 19 years & older

Pneumococcal Vaccine

➤ 90670 (Pneumovax 13)

- Children ages 12 months to 15 months
- Adults ages 19 years to 26 years; catch- up vaccination only
- 1 dose for adults age 65 and older

➤ 90732 (Pneumovax 23)

- High-risk children per CDC recommended immunization schedule
- Adults ages 65 years & older; catch- up vaccination only

Meningococcal Vaccine

➤ 90620 (Bexsero)

- Children ages 10 years to 18 years
- Adults ages 19 years to 23 years

➤ 90621 (Trumenba)

- Ages 0 to 6 months and 10 to 23 years

➤ 90734 (Menactra)

- High-risk children ages less than 11 years per the CDC recommended immunization schedule
- Children ages 11 years to 12 years; 16 year booster
- Unvaccinated College Students ages 19 years to 21 years - students living in a dorm
- Adults per the CDC recommended immunization schedule

Tetanus-Diphtheria, Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis Vaccines

➤ 90714 (Tenivac)

- Children ages 7 years & older with unknown/incomplete series of Td vaccines
- Adult booster every 10 years & older

➤ 90715 (Boostrix)

- Children, 1 dose, 11 years to 12 years
- Children less than 19 years, catch- up vaccination only
- Adults 19 & older
- Pregnant women with each pregnancy

Vaccine Administration

- Administration charges are covered when billed by the correct route with the appropriate procedure code on the same date of service
- The Medicare administration codes G0008 (influenza vaccine) and G0009 (pneumococcal vaccine) are covered for INTEGRITY members when billed with the appropriate procedure code
- Vaccine Administration with counseling, member ages 0 years to 18 years:
 - 90460 first or only component of each vaccine or toxoid administered
 - 90461 each additional vaccine or toxoid component administered
- Vaccine Administration without counseling, all ages:
 - 90471 first or only component of each injectable vaccine or toxoid administered
 - 90472 each additional, injectable vaccine or toxoid component administered
 - 90473 first or only component of each oral/nasal vaccine or toxoid administered
 - 90474 each additional oral/nasal vaccine or toxoid component administered
